4) Éléonore Mine Project, Opinaca Mines Ltd.

WHEREAS on December 18, 2019, the Review Committee (COMEX) received, for its recommendation, an application to amend the certificate of authorization for the compensation for adverse effects on wetlands, bodies of water and riparian environments for the Éléonore Mine Project and, on December 9, 2020, received additional information (answers to the committee's questions and comments).

The COMEX members reviewed the documents submitted by the proponent. After considering all the information received in relation to this project, COMEX recommends that the Provincial Administrator authorize the amendment to the global certificate of authorization issued on November 10, 2011, subject to certain conditions. The overall analysis and conditions are enclosed in a separate document.

The COMEX members have reviewed the documents submitted by the proponent. After considering all the information received in relation to this project, COMEX recommends that the Provincial Administrator authorize the amendment to the global certificate of authorization issued on November 10, 2011.

7) Varia

a. Federal consultations on the Rose Lithium-Tantalum and James Bay Lithium mining projects

Vanessa Chalifour said that she met with the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (IAAC) on March 24, 2021 to go over the virtual public hearings held by COMEX on February 15, 16 and 18, 2021. The IAAC plans to hold consultations on its preliminary environmental assessment report on April 14 and 15, 2021.

b. Rose Lithium-Tantalum mining project: Discussion on the coming steps in the project review process and review of briefs and public opinions

Vanessa Chalifour said that the COMEX secretariat received no comments or briefs following the public hearings. The public had until March 18, 2021 to submit comments and briefs.

Several issues were raised by participants during the hearings and COMEX took note and will consider all of them in its final recommendation. COMEX will hold a specific meeting on April 8, 2021 to continue discussing this project.

COMEX also raised the possibility of talking with other stakeholders, in particular regarding road transportation. A meeting could be planned soon for that purpose.

c. Meeting of the monitoring committee for CC22.1 research project – "Portrait climatique EIBJ-Nunavik-AT" (climate change)

No new developments.

d. Email request received by COMEX: Indigenous peoples in impact assessment project

Following a discussion of the request received by email concerning the Indigenous peoples in impact assessment project, it was decided that Luc Lainé would contact the person to provide general information about COMEX and its mandate and refer the person to the Cree Nation Government and the Québec government to get the details of the request.

e. Analysis of annual and monitoring reports pending review

Vanessa Chalifour confirmed that the MELCC is in charge of reviewing the monitoring reports for the Eastmain/Rupert hydroelectric development project. COMEX should receive the initial analyses in the coming weeks or months.

f. COMEX annual report 2020-2021

The executive secretary will update the factual information contained in the annual report. Luc Lainé will write the chairman's message. A few issues that could be discussed in the annual report were mentioned, including offsetting the loss of wetlands and riparian environments, and the cumulative impacts of road transportation.
