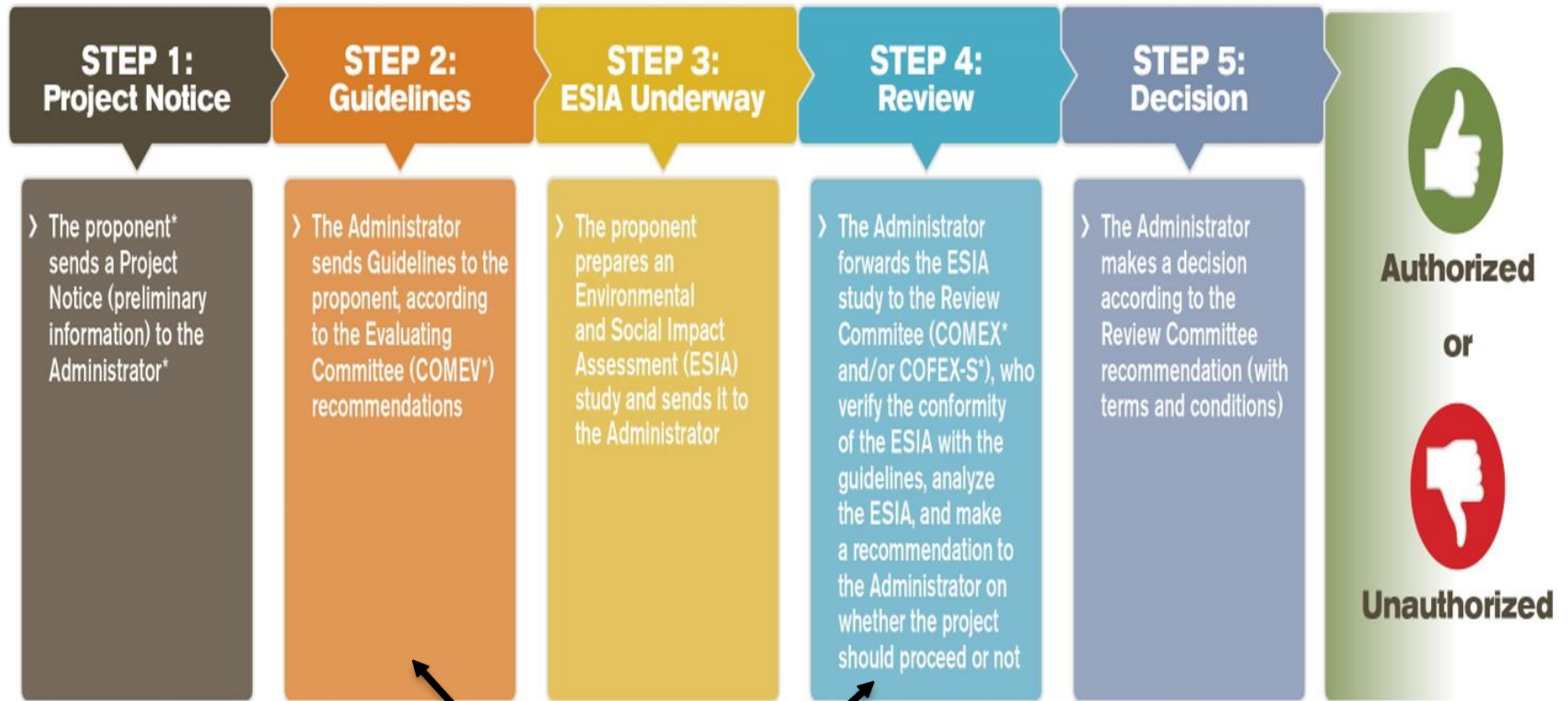

Our health comments on the ESIAs

1-Toxicological

- Is there any toxicity associated with the mine that can impact the community?

2-Psycho-social

- Emergency plans in case of accidents
- Drugs and alcohol
- Increase in traffic
- Safety of land-users on the trapline
- Impact on CMC
- Etc...

Our original comments for Blackrock mine ESIA (first round)

- Physical danger posed by the mine to the land users
- Dust management plan was not provided
- What was being done to help workers with drug and alcohol problems. Also financial planning
- What was being done for cultural integration, and knowledge of Cree culture (issue raised by the tallyman)

Our second round of comments

- All the responses by the mine were accepted with the exception of the one relating to cultural integration.
- In our response we provided some ideas such as:
 1. Cultural holidays during goose break (in accordance with the company's holiday policy)
 2. Cultural site such as a teepee (michuap) on the mine site
 3. A Cree cultural day
 4. Provide documentation on the Crees or information in the orientation video presentation
